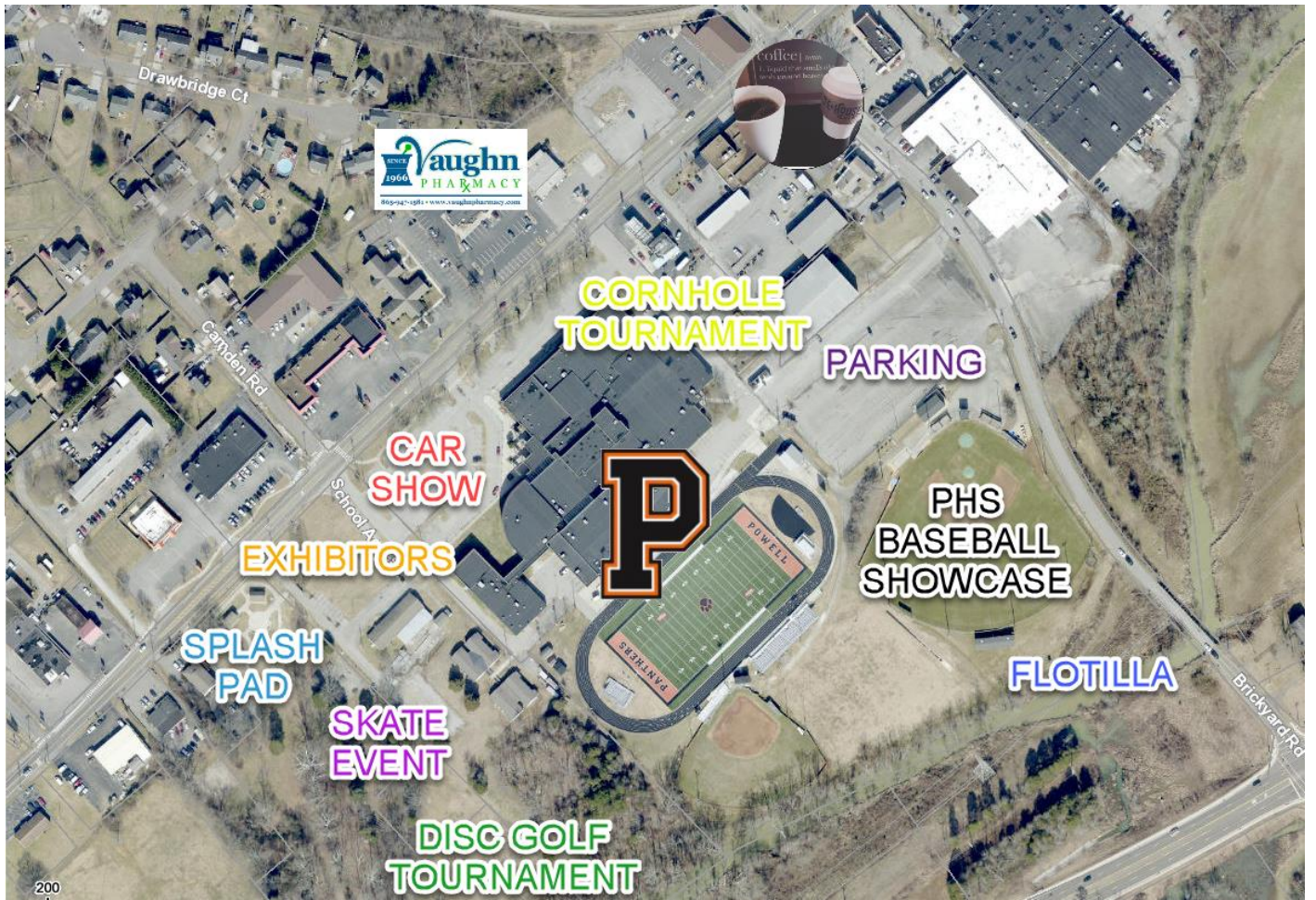

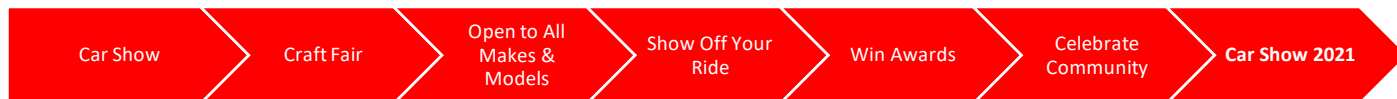
7th Annual Travis Wegener Memorial Car Show

This exceptional all-volunteer-driven event honors the life and memory of Travis Wegener – a Mustang loving ‘Powell Guy’ with a huge heart for his community. All proceeds from the event support projects that enhance the Powell Community and honor Travis’s legacy.

The car show, sponsored by the Tennessee Valley Mustang Club – Travis’s club – is open to all makes and models – cars, bikes and trucks are welcome! Over 100 vehicles are expected. The car show corral is the main parking area at Powell High School – across from Vaughn Pharmacy. Entrance fee is just \$20 and the show is open to the public for no charge. There will be music, a giant American Flag on display from Rural Metro/AMR, vendor show, awards ceremony and so much more. Congressman Tim Burchett and other dignitaries will open the event.

Hamburgers, hot dogs, chips and drinks will be available for purchase, with all proceeds going to the Travis Wegener Memorial Fund. The food stuffs are notably donated by our local Food City grocery store, are prepared by members of the Mustang Club, and sold by volunteers from the Powell Business & Professional Association. 4th Annual Powell Station Flotilla *on Beaver Creek*

The Fourth Annual Powell Station Flotilla is a free community event facilitated by the Powell Business & Professional Association's Enhance Powell Committee and directed by the Beaver Creek Kayak Club. This year's Floatmaster is TN State Representative, Michele Carringer.

The nearly two-hour float down Beaver Creek begins at the Landing at Powell High School (adjacent the Baseball diamond) and ends just west of Clinton Highway near the Weigel's flagship store. Come join 250+ kayakers, canoers and stand-up paddle boarders as they get a lot of paddles wet! This is a great event for all ages and skill levels. Knox County Mayor Glen Jacobs, his team at Knox County Parks and Rec, and The Beaver Creek Kayak Club, along with many volunteers; have done a lot of work to Clear, Clean, and Care for Beaver Creek. Come see the results of all their hard work on a relaxing float, free from log jams and litter.

Rental watercraft can be sourced from our friends at River Sports Outfitters <https://fareharbor.com/embeds/book/riversportsoutfitters/items/58983/availability/696423988/book/?flow=187311> for a modest fee. Rented boats will be delivered to the put-in and taken away from the take-out. Each rental includes personal floatation devices and paddles. One and two-person boats are available.

Those with their own watercraft can quickly drop off their gear at the put-in site with help provided by volunteers from our local Boy Scout Troops, Powell High School Baseball Team, and Beaver Creek Kayak Club members. Participants will be given a boat-check ticket before entering the water for boat retrieval after the event. Free parking is available at the nearby PHS Complex lot. Public restrooms are available in the High School and at Powell Station Park.

As always, be safe on the water. Law enforcement and safety guidance is available from agents of the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency, Rural Metro/AMR and Knox Rescue Squad. Overall traffic flow will be managed by Knox County's finest – officers of the Knox County Sheriff's Office.

Following the float, free transportation for participants and their gear will be provided by members of First Baptist Church and the Karns Community Fair organization. Look for the Weigel's tent at the take-out for delicious refreshments while you wait for the transport vans. Guests will be dropped off at the main event area where they can grab lunch and take part in the other parts of the Celebration. A boat-check system will be utilized to collect watercraft and security will be provided for all the boats and gear.

Water levels can fluctuate and impact this event and changing weather may cancel. Please check the PBPA Facebook Page for the most up-to-date information. Beaver Creek is a State of Tennessee waterway and participation in this event is free and voluntary. Participation serves as Registration and Release of Liability.

TENNESSEE PADDLESPORTS LAWS

Human-powered vessels, such as:
CANOES • KAYAKS • STAND UP PADDLEBOARDS (SUP)

An approved, wearable life jacket for each person must be readily accessible. Throw cushions do not meet this requirement.

Life jacket(s) must be on board, not attached by a line or leash.

Persons under 13 years old must wear a life jacket while underway. Drifting is considered underway.

All paddle craft must be able to exhibit a white light or lantern after sunset or during times of restricted visibility.

Boater's state registration card must be on board if boat is propelled by motor or a trolling motor.

A fishing license is required by all persons 13 years or older assisting or attempting to take fish.

Do not litter. It is unlawful to throw or sink litter from a boat. In the event that a boat turns over, all contents must be retrieved.

It is unlawful to use or be in possession of drugs or controlled substances while boating or paddling.

Use or possession of alcohol by individuals who are underage is prohibited.

No person shall operate or interfere with the safe operation of any motorboat or vessel.

All boats are subject to inspection.

All navigation rules apply.

Keep a proper lookout at all times.

OTHER HELPFUL HINTS:

Inflatable belt pack life jackets need to be worn with the device **in front of the body**, not turned to the back side of the body.



Inflatable life jackets are not approved for anyone less than 16 years old.

Do *not* overload your boat.

Other rules, regulations, and laws may apply.
